Dear Family and Friends,

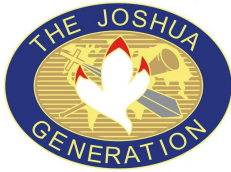

2007–2008 HIGHLIGHTS

2007

- **8TH Joshua Generation International Leaders Summit (St. Laurent du Pont, France)**
 - Over a dozen countries represented, from Africa, Europe, Asia and the U.S.A.
- **Mission Trip to Nepal**
 - **Over 300 pastors and church leaders trained for ministry**
 - **Outreach dinner to government leaders** — The catalyst for the Christian leaders to minister to their government leaders.
 - **History was made** — In December 2007, Christmas, for the first time, was declared a holiday in Nepal. Since then, the church that invited us has held a yearly Christmas dinner outreach to the government leaders of Nepal.

2008

- **Jose ministered in Wales with Dr. Rowland Evans**, Founder of Horizons and Nations Ministries.
- **Jose ministered in Scotland** – As result of our mission trips to Bulgaria, we met a young man by the name of Iliya, who translated for Jose. It was his first experience to translate for a foreigner. Before we left, Iliya told Jose that he would like to preach the gospel and be like him. Jose laid hands on him and prayed. Shortly thereafter, Iliya met a missionary who gave him a scholarship to attend a bible college in New York. Iliya is now the associate pastor of Mercy Church in Glasgow, Scotland. Seeds never die when the Word of God is planted in the hearts of people who have fertile ground like Iliya.
- **A Joshua Generation International Fellowship started at Westador Clubhouse in Houston (June 2008)** This is a pioneer training center for whoever wants to be a *disciple of Christ*. We have had international guest speakers from Nepal, Cameroon, Wales, Ethiopia, Bulgaria and The Philippines.
- **9TH Joshua Generation International Leaders Summit (Northwest Forest Conference Center- Cypress, Texas)**
 - **Madame Sujata Koirala**, Member of Parliament & Cabinet Minister (daughter of the former Nepal Prime Minister), came and accepted Christ as her personal Savior during the Leaders Summit.
 - **Delegates who attended the Leaders Summits received the challenge to go to the nations.**
 - **Larry and Kathleen Beck, Percy and Ruth Trballo** went to Rwanda explore possibilities for missions and business opportunities to help believers.

- **9TH Joshua Generation International Leaders Summit (continued)**
 - **Rabbi Steve Kennard** spent a month last October to teach the believers with his teaching materials on Grace.
 - **Sheryn Turner (A Touch Of Grace Ministries)** spent the whole month of May ministering in Katmandu, Nepal and its neighboring cities.
 - **ABC-The Key** (founded by Dr. Carolyn Glover and Dr. Teri Jones), an English training program was introduced in Rwanda by Larry Becks. This is a wonderful opportunity as Rwanda has declared English as their official national language and not French.
 - **Rey & Vicky Quilaton** are in the Philippines conducting outreach to Muslim communities with the gospel.
 - **Pastor Patrick Chambron** (St. Laurent du Pont, France) teamed up with Jose to minister in Cameroon.
 - **Pastor Christian Riviere** (Grenoble, France) ministered in Kinshasa, Democratic Republic of Congo.
 - **Rev. Serge Divounguy**, Director of Air Operations in the United Nations, joined the team to minister in Gabon.
- **Joshua Generation Team traveled to Cameroon and Gabon-** A team composed of Jim Hadfield, Mike Westbrooks, Allan Josselyn, Pastor Patrick Chambron, David Pascua and Jose Pascua ministered in churches and also to government officials of both countries.
- **The Joshua Generation International Network celebrated its 20th Anniversary on October 16, 2008.** Over sixty people came and our guest was David Wauchope from Australia. David and his wife Jan traveled with us to the former Soviet Union, they saw miracles of God's intervention in human affairs. Due to Hurricane Ike, we were unable to celebrate on the network's anniversary date, which was officially September 9, 2008.
- **Arabian Peninsula Consultation-** Jose and David participated at a prayer conference in Al Ain, United Arab Emirates, where 250 leaders from 30 countries came together.
- **Bulgaria Outreach-** Bishop Totev reported of their outreach into Greece. In spite of the upheaval in Greece, they were able to preach and teach in different churches.
- **Finland** – Jukka Lemmetyinen and team traveled to Israel for a mission trip.
- **Korea** – Mel Tari spoke to thousands of young people who are ready to move forward as missionaries.
- **Nepal** – Pastor Rajendra Sundas reports of the Holy Spirit moving in that country.
