How great and wonderful is our God! We want to share with you some brief highlights of what the Holy Spirit is doing among the nations in the Joshua Generation International Network:

Nepal (Excerpts from a letter by Pastor Raju Sundas)

- "...an influential couple, Mr. Sher and Laxmi are brand new believers. The husband was a body guard of the former Prime Minister during the rule of King Gyanendra... he was also the VIP guard for the king. I am thankful for the baptism of his family. This couple now has given us a place to start a church in their own home."
- "This past year Christmas was a unique experience for the Christians in Nepal because Christmas is now a national holiday for the Nepalese people. The celebration was attended by government leaders. We were able to share the love and message of the Gospel to them."
- "We hosted a Christmas party for 1,000 street children. We presented clothes, food, and the Gospel to the neglected children."
- "...from January 21st we had a two-week non-stop prayer meeting. After two weeks, people who left the church came back, repented and re-dedicated themselves to the Lord!"

Cameroon

"Joshua Generation is moving forward in Cameroon. We want to register The Joshua Generation with the government of Cameroon. We are planning an international conference in August called "A Summit of God's Glory in Africa." Please advise..." - **Apostle Albert Itoumbou**

Bulgaria

- "We are ready to have the next Leaders Summit here in Bulgaria. Can you come sometime in the Fall this year?" - **Bishop Milcho Totev**
- "Joyce, the ladies in Bulgaria are ready to receive you to speak and minister to them - when can you come?" - **Anne Totev**

Bhutan

"My only prayer and vision is to reach and train many Spirit-filled Joshuas, and plant 500 churches in Bhutan through The Joshua Generation ministry. As you are faithfully extending the vision to the churches in Nepal, will you also include Bhutan in your vision and mission?" - **Pastor John Tamang**

A Loving Tribute to Rev. Carl and Maxine Lucht – Pioneer Missionaries

Two of our close friends who partnered and supported us through the years went home to be with the Lord. Rev. Carl Lucht passed on to glory February 28th, and 28 hours later his beloved partner in life, Maxine, went home to be with Carl and the Lord Jesus.

When General Douglas McArthur wired the churches in America to send missionaries to Japan, only three couples responded, and Carl and Maxine were one of the three couples. Maxine, in her desire to communicate to the Japanese as they passed by everyday, was inspired to write many songs and one of them was ***“Do You Care?”***

Carl and Maxine answered God's call. Today the challenge is the same, “Who will go for us?” (“Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us? Then I said, Here am I, send me!” - Isaiah 6:8)

Rowland Evans of Wales shared these words of wisdom with us in one of the Leaders Summits. “Don't stay too long in Jerusalem or you will be too old to go. Don't linger in Judaea and Samaria. They maybe very nice places to stay but you will lose your vision and your call will become stale. It is a very sad day when we become inwardly aware that our opportunity has passed...and there is now no way in which it can be retrieved.”
